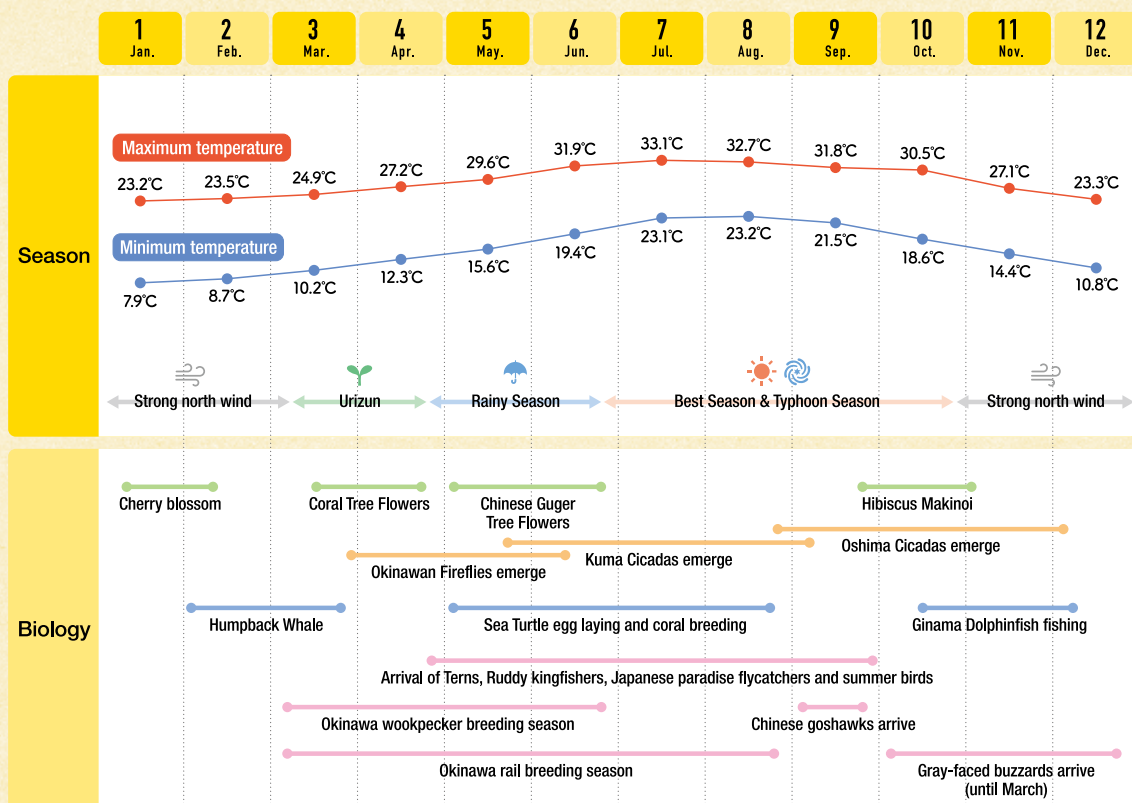

Among them, Kunigami is a place full of charms such as forests brimming with vitality, soothing beaches, and breathtaking views that will touch your heart.

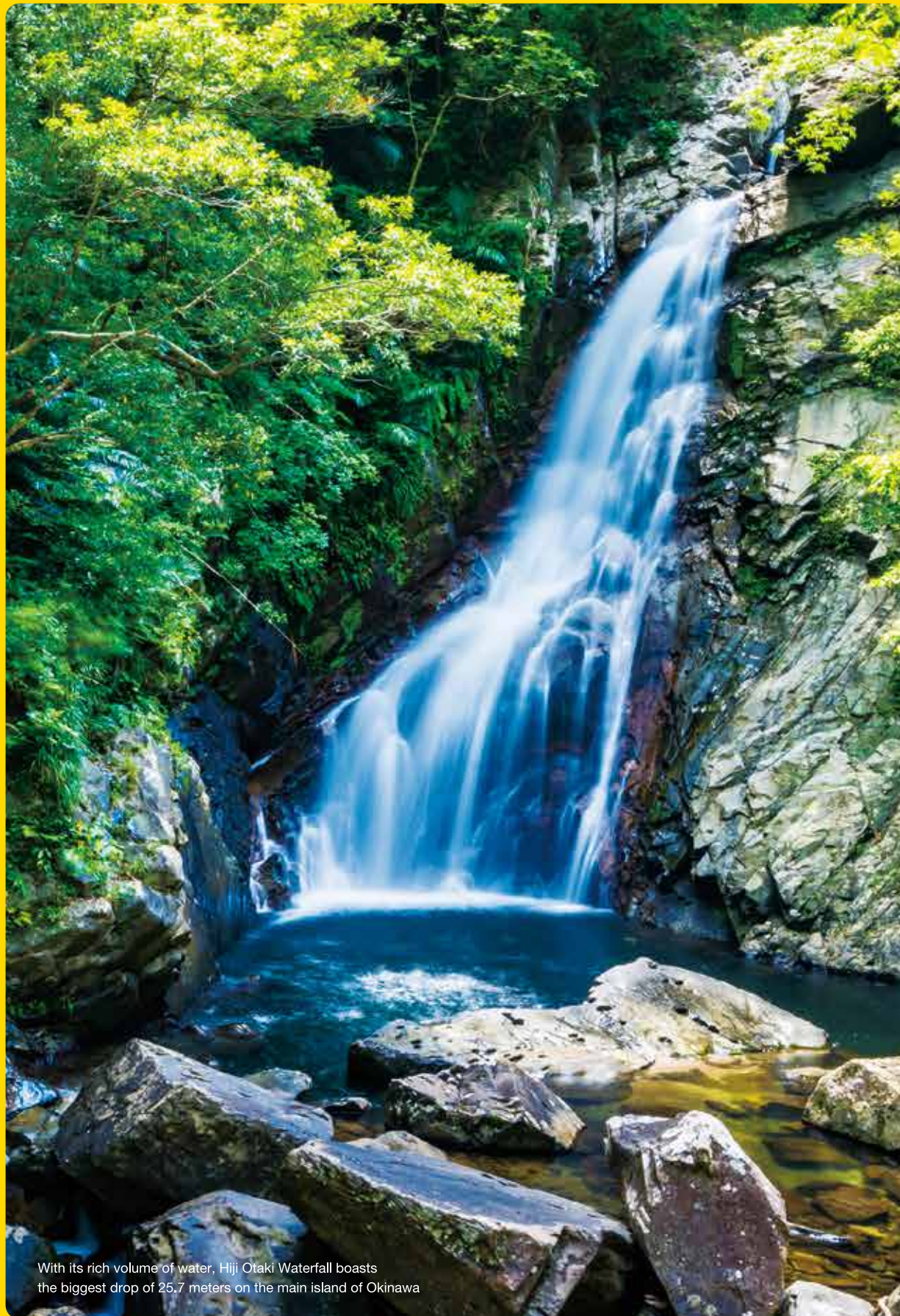

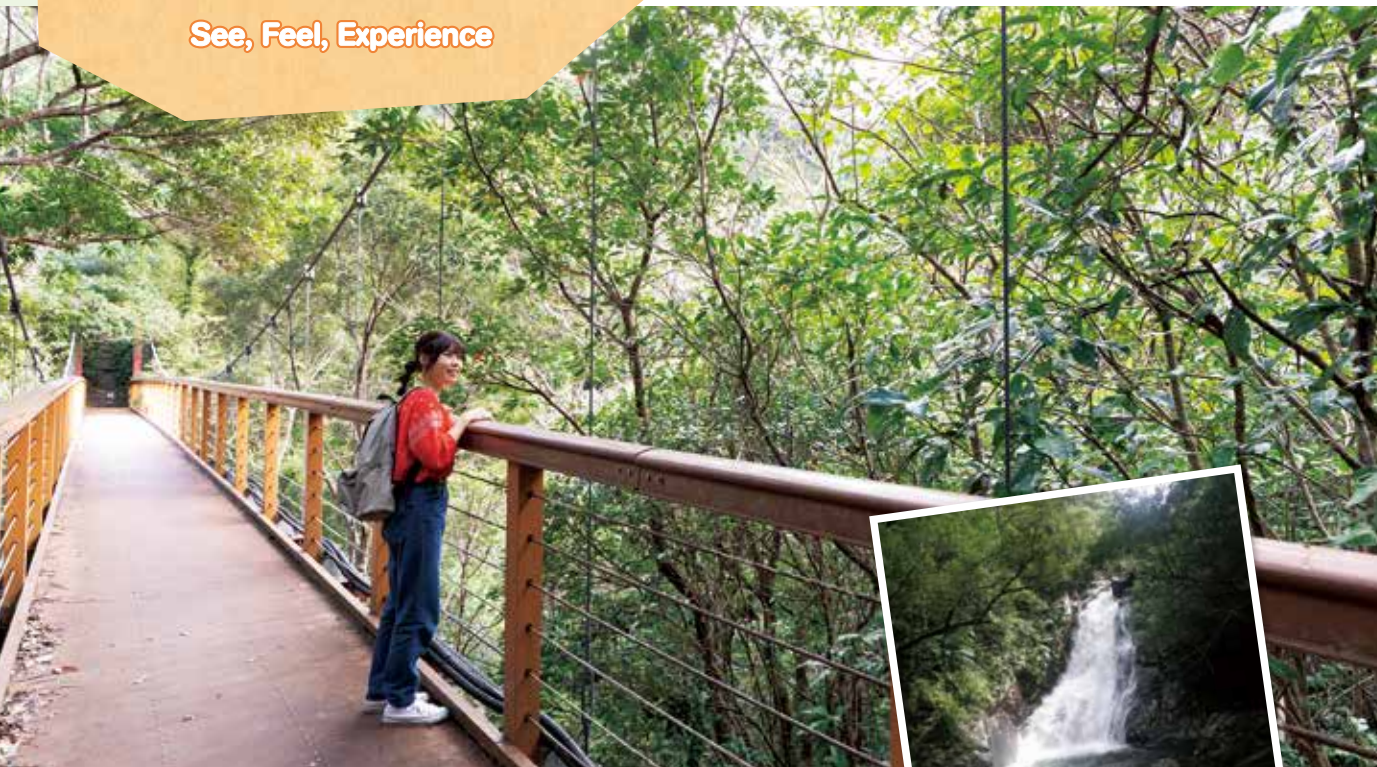
### This is what a Yambaruina (Okinawa rail) is!

Yambaruina, a precious endemic species that lives in the rich forests of Okinawa. It is about 30 cm long with a black-and-white stripe that goes down its throat and belly and a bright red beak. Having little wings with muscles that are not well-developed, they are unable to fly. However, they have excellent leg strength and can run at a speed of 40 km/h. They sometimes cross the road in search of food, so if you are driving, watch out!

The best way to find delicious food on your trip is to go to places that locals eat at. Here we introduce set meals, Okinawa soba, and sweets made with local ingredients. Find and feast on gourmet food that you can only enjoy in Kunigami!

## 1 Inobuta rice bowl

A wild pig rice bowl that combines wild boar and pig meat. The succulent and sweet fat is exquisite.



## 3 Eggs Benedict

The taste of bacon and black pepper pops out from the creamy Hollandaise sauce to keep you coming back for more!

## 2 Chicken nanban set meal

It is topped with a handmade tartar sauce that blends juicy chicken with bitter melon grown in Kunigami.



## 4 Okinawa soba

The thick noodles taste great with the strips of pork and the broth perfected by the chef, making it a dish you'll want to enjoy again and again.



## 5 Okumidori tea cheese tart

A popular cheese tart made using the new "Oku Midori" tea, which is the tea harvested earliest in the year in Japan, giving it a rich nutritious flavor.



## 7 Brown sugar syrup zenzai (shaved ice)

Cool, cold, and sweet Okinawa zenzai with plenty of black honey and motherly affection.



## 6 Gelato

(purple sweet potato & mango)  
Burrito (jerk chicken)

Eight types of Italian-style ice cream such as brown sugar and awamori raisins are served with four types of filling burritos. They are both delicious!



## 8 Sata andagi

(plain & brown sugar)

Okinawa's version of the donut, sata andagi, is handmade one by one at the store. The surface is crispy while the inside is lovely and moist. Get some to take along with you for the road!



## 1 Wild boar and pork specialty restaurant Waya

A no-frills diner run by the Miyazato family who is involved with what goes on the plate right from its production. Free-range wild pigs that enjoy a care-free life provide good quality meat. This meat is also very popular for use in a traditional Japanese shabu-shabu hotpot.

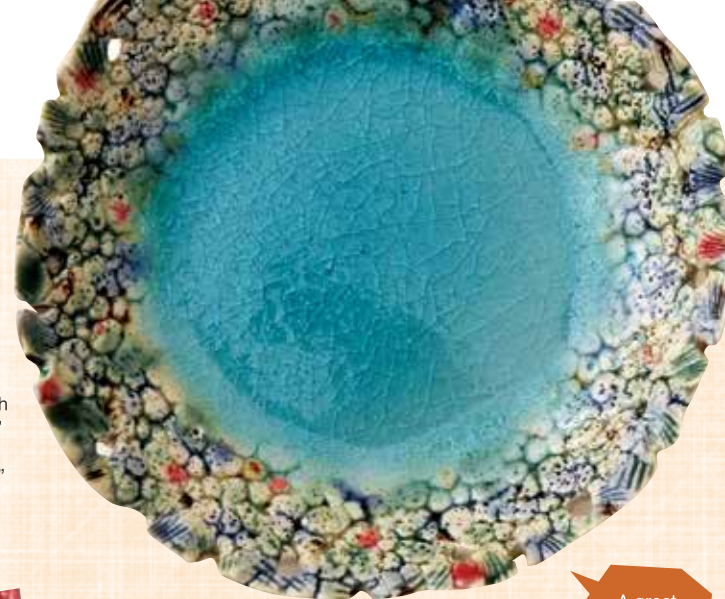

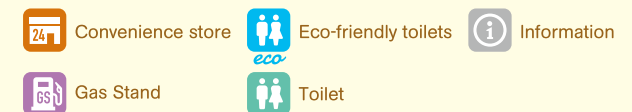

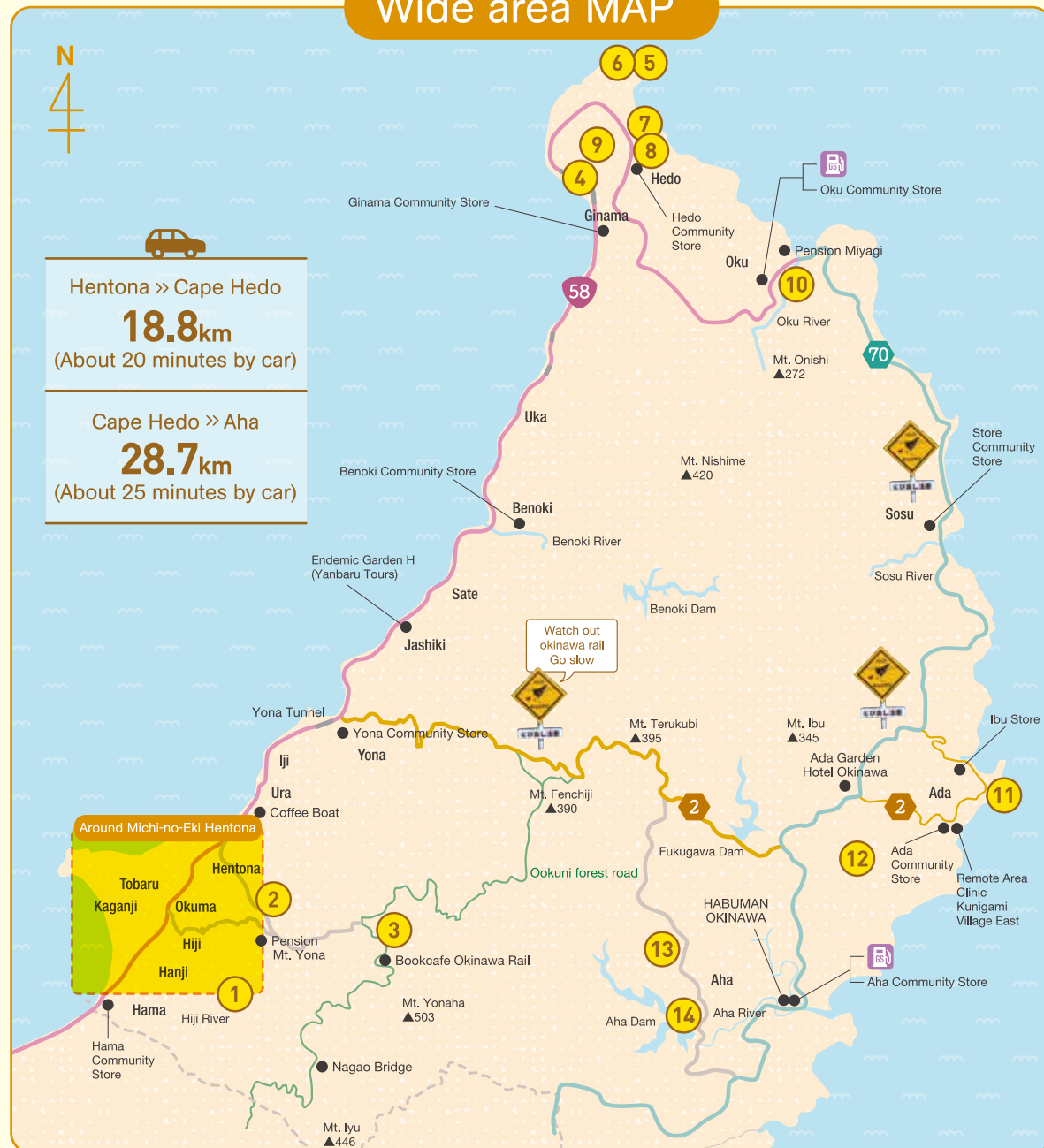
