










Kunigami Village is full of sights, such as Cape Hedo with its stunning view from the cliffs and the rich forests with beautiful clear streams.

What Does Kunigami Have to Offer?

unigami is located on the northernmost edge of Okinawa Island and features a large forest that is full of subtropical trees. This very same precious forest was registered as a World Natural Heritage site in 2021. Here, you can discover Okinawa's charm beyond the beaches and the sea, including cliffs that offer some of the most amazing views in Okinawa, beautiful waterfalls that lie deep in the jungle, a small village with a nostalgic atmosphere, and delicious local cuisine.







#### This is what a Yambarukuina (Okinawa rail) is!

Yambarukuina, a precious endemic species that lives in the rich forests of Okinawa. It is about 30 cm long with a black-and-white stripe that goes down its throat and belly and a bright red beak. Having little wings with muscles that are not well-developed, they are unable to fly. However, they have excellent leg strength and can run at a speed of 40 km/h. They sometimes cross the road in search of food, so if you are driving, watch out!






